Introduction

The start of 2020 brought about an unprecedented global challenge: the spread of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), classed by the WHO as a global pandemic. As a result, strict confinement measures, including travel bans, have been introduced around the world since early March.

Despite the restrictions, the EU4Environment Action is being implemented. All formal and informal meetings and discussions are now being substituted by teleconferencing.

It is difficult at this point to assess how long travel restrictions will be maintained and whether it will be possible to organise the EU4Environment Regional Assembly that would review progress on EU4Environment implementation - initially planned as a face-to-face meeting in September 2020. To anticipate the possible postponement of the Regional Assembly meeting towards the end of 2020, it is proposed to organise virtual EU4Environment consultations with each of the six Eastern Partnership (EaP) countries and the implementing organisations.

Purpose of virtual country consultations

- Review the in-country situation in light of COVID-19, post COVID-19 recovery plans and their potential impacts on greening the economy;
- Present progress with EU4Environment implementation in each EaP country;
- Discuss plans for the rest of the year in light of the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Discuss options for organising the Regional Assembly meeting in the second half of 2020.

Participants

- EU4Environment National Focal Points (NFPs) from the Ministries of Environment and of Economy of each EaP country;
- Selected participants invited by NFPs (e.g. national focal points under the UNECE Espoo Convention);
- European Commission: representatives of DG NEAR (DG ENV and DG CLIMA may also join) and respective EU Delegations;
- Implementing Partners (representatives of OECD, UNIDO, UNEP, UNECE);
- National Action Coordinators;
- Implementing Partners' co-ordinators could be invited on individual basis (e.g. UN Resident Coordinators of support to the country's post COVID-19 recovery plan, UNIDO Resident Coordinators).
