Result 1. Greener decision making (1.1, 1.2, 1.4 - UNEP)

Progress in 2020

- ✓ Regular support for organization/logistics of interministerial dialogue on Green Economy (GE): GG/NIC meeting (14.02.2020; 11.09.2020; 12.02.2021); country consultations (29.05.2020)
- ✓ Translation and launch of Romanian version of an introductory GE course; discussions with Academy of Public Administration to promote and host the course further
- ✓ Nomination of candidates from various government bodies for participation in an in-depth Green Economy (GE) policy-making course: 14 candidates nominated; learning needs assessment conducted; course to start next week
- ✓ Awareness raising campaigns: National High Level Round table "Green Economy. Made in Moldova" (31.01.2020 and 29.01.2021); EUGreenWeek 2021 (31.04-04.06.2021), WED2021 (05.06.2021).

- ✓ Continued inter-ministerial dialogue on GE and overall oversight of EU4Environment GG/NIC meeting
- ✓ Promotion (and future hosting) of the introductory GE course among various civil servants; GE course integrated in the ongoing programs at the APA
- ✓ Delivery of a tailored, interactive **GE policy making/analysis training course to nominated participants** (including all EaP countries); analysis of sectoral policies by trained civil using skills obtained
- ✓ **Investment needs assessment**: in alignment with review of national GE strategy (priority sectors discussed at NIC meeting of 11.09.2020).
- ✓ Awareness raising campaigns for general public: 6th National High Level Round table "Green Economy. Made in Moldova", national and global campaigns, in synergy with the activity 5.2 on communication





Result 1. Greener decision making (1.3 - UNECE: SEA/EIA)

Progress in 2020



- ✓ Legislative assistance
 - **review of EIA and SEA legislation** completed, discussed at MARDE's Working Group on Legislation Amendment;
 - agreed *terms of reference* + legal experts for next phase (drafting amendments) in place
- ✓ Two Guidelines on (1) Quality Control of SEA
 Documentation; (2) QC of transb. EIA Documentation draft
 ToRs + experts secured, development process moved to 2021
- ✓ RM's delegation (7 participants) shared experience with the other EaP countries and received training at Subregional Workshop on the Application of SEA and Transb. EIA organized by UNECE 26-27 October
- ✓ **Video on the Espoo Convention (transboundary EIA)** in ENG developed and launched at the *Meeting of the Parties to the Espoo Convention/MOP to the SEA Protocol* (8-11 December)

- ✓ Legislative assistance (cont'd) **legislation**amendments drafting and related activities (Jan-Oct);
- ✓ Two Guidelines on Quality Control of SEA and EIA Documentation development (January to Q3);
- ✓ 2nd Awareness-Raising Workshop on SEA in the Republic of Moldova (date tbc);
- ✓ SEA course for public servants + university-level course on SEA and transboundary EIA: development to be initiated by June;
- ✓ Translation of the video on the Espoo Convention into Romanian (April June);

- ✓ Finalization of the draft Law on amendments to EIA, SEA and other relevant laws (Q3);
- ✓ Finalization of 2 Guidelines on Quality Control of SEA and EIA Documentation (Q3);
- ✓ Training Workshop on Quality Control of SEA and EIA Documentation (after the finalization of the draft Guidelines above);
- ✓ Identification of a draft plan/programme for a **pilot project** on transboundary SEA *or* on transboundary EIA + preparation of a team of experts + its initiation (Q4);
- ✓ Finalized SEA course for public servants + finalized university-level course on SEA and transboundary EIA (by the end of the year);
- \checkmark Finalized video on the Espoo Convention in RO (in Q3); development of awareness-raising materials (Q3-Q4);
- ✓ Initiation of development of a **model for a SEA on-line database** for six beneficiary countries.



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Result 2. Circular economy and new growth opportunities (2.1, 2.2 - UNIDO)

Progress in 2020

- ✓ **Consultations with NFPs** and other stakeholders preparing a tender for a National Implementing Partner (NIP);
- ✓ Tender to identify the RECP NIP closed (October 2020);
- ✓ ToR for RECP National Coordinator developed in consultation with NFPs (October-November 2020) and Vacancy Announcement launched (December 2020);
- ✓ Presentation of UNIDO activities and work plan related to SMEs at the Conference on Launching of the Program on Greening SMEs, organized by ODIMM (03 June 2020);
- ✓ Identified synergies with the GREEN SMEs Country Program led by ODIMM (in synergy with OECD and UNEP activities, April-June 2020);
- ✓ EIP international expert institution contracted and EIP methodology application to IPs and FEZ (Eco-industrial parks feasibility) prepared (December 2020);

Progress in 2020

- ✓ Progress on SPP since 2017 is under review by the International and National Experts in consultation with the Public Procurement Agency (report to be presented in Feb 2021);
- ✓ Assessment and the draft Roadmap on eco-labeling prepared and presented to the stakeholders at webinar (18 Dec 2020) (PA EcoContact)
- ✓ Consultations with Organization for the Small and Medium Enterprise Sector Development (ODIMM) to assist with ecoinnovation promotion and trainings
- ✓ Coordinated the support for the Use of strategic approaches on waste management (March September 2020) development of the National Waste Management Programme (NWMP) and National Waste Action Plan (NWAP); initiation of the process of development of NWMP and NWAP (ToR, local partner contracted (September-November 2020)

- ✓ Draft a Governmental Decision of SPP
- ✓ Identify **priority product groups**, review market readiness, update the sustainability criteria for priority products
- ✓ Draft **SPP guidelines for priority product groups**
- ✓ Draft regulation on eco-labelling and organize first public hearings

Result 3. Environmental level playing field (OECD)

Progress in 2020

- ✓ Mission and preparatory work (draft ToR) for a follow-up (capacity development) project on the designed Clean Public Transport (CPT) Programme; project launched with a kick off meeting on 5 February 2021
- ✓ Assistance with developing a self-assessment tool for SMEs and assistance with the development of metrics for measuring SME greening nationally (March – May);
- ✓ Progress on an assessment report on the compliance assurance system and the system of administrative sanctions, monetary payments and penalties for non-compliance (information-gathering and interviews).
- ✓ Comments on the **draft law on IED** and support on its implementation (November);
- Reviewing and reforming the current set-up of the National Ecological Fund: assessment, ToR for local expert (March-July); Call for applications (August), selection of the consultant (October);
- ✓ **Estimation of fossil-fuel subsidies for 2016-2019** for the OECD-IEA Fossil-fuel subsidies database (July December);
- ✓ Launch of work on **green bonds** (project call for tender completed in December)
- ✓ Launch of work on administrative capacity for environmental management project (discussions on ad-hoc expert support to the Environmental Agency)

- Implementation of the Clean Public Transport (CPT) Programme; including capacity development
- ✓ Finalisation of the assessment report on the compliance assurance system and on administrative sanctions, monetary payments and penalties for non-compliance (Q2).
- ✓ Development of the Operational Manual of the **National Ecological Fund** and staff training;
- ✓ Collection of data on energy-related taxes (TBD);
- ✓ Fact-finding virtual mission on green bonds project (March-April);
- ✓ Analytical report on existing/required administrative capacity in the environmental sector (July) and development of a roadmap for improving administrative capacity in the environmental sector,
- Expert support to on the application of General Binding Rules (for a specific sector) (TBD);

Result 4. Ecosystem Services and Livelihoods (the World Bank)

Progress in 2020

- ✓ Signed the agreement between the WB and EC:
- ✓ Improve resilience through the preservation of ecosystem services, with a focus on forests and protected areas
- ✓ Countries' natural capital better conserved and more resilient livelihoods ensured

- ✓ Inseption phase January June 2021
- ✓ Actions:
- Launching a shared network of protected areas involving EU and neighbouring countries
- Support for community actions for forest conservation and sustainable use to increase non-timber goods production, energy efficiency related to biomass
- Actions to limit the trade in illegal timber,
- Support for the identification and development of innovative financing schemes for sustainable management of ecosystem services





Result 5. Monitoring progress at environment-economy nexus (OECD) (5.3. Green growth indicators)

Progress in 2020

- ✓ Overview of available green growth indicators in the OECD database for the Republic of Moldova and initial internal discussions on its extension and update;
- ✓ Propose integration of the GGIs in the Program of statistical works for 2021 and placement on the NBS and other related sites (August September 2020);
- ✓ Country profile (developed and disseminated).

- ✓ Update of the **Green Growth Indicators Report** (2017): enlarge, if possible, the number of green growth indicators, identifying new ones, publishing online data, ensuring synergy with Moldova 2030/SDGs objectives and targets, SoER of Moldova and updated Program on the promotion of green economy for 2021-2023, considering integrating data into the OECD stat base;
- ✓ Development of the next edition of the GGIs-based country profile

- ✓ EaP country virtual consultations (Republic of Moldova - 29 May 2020): participation of NFPs, DG NEAR, DG Environment, all IP; Summary of the event developed and circulated.
