The SME Policy Index 2020


- ✓ The SME Policy Index allows for **benchmarking** on SME policy between Partner Countries and with EU Members, improve SME policy-making and enhance the **institutional capacity** for policy implementation
- ✓ Partner organisations (OECD, ETF, EBRD, EU) have developed a dedicated methodology -the SME Policy Index- for broader application of the SBA (SME Policy Index conducted in over 40 countries in 5 regions)













Structure of the SME Policy Index

Progress towards SME-supportive policies in EaP countries since 2012



Main observations

- Substantial progress across almost all dimensions
- **Good performance** in Pillar A **Responsive Government**
- Solid improvements in Pillar B Entrepreneurial Human Capital
- Access to Finance remains a key issue
- Long way to go in Pillar D Internationalisation, and Pillar E Business Support
- Georgia maintains position of top performer, **Ukraine** is top reformer in comparison to 2016



- Multi-year SME development strategies
- SME agencies established

- Promotion of culture of business rescue

- Clearly define relations between agencies and ministries
- Assess the impact of legal acts on SMEs
- Improve public-private consultations
- Upgrade IT skills and requirements
- Assign registration agencies the task of managing enterprise data collection
- Implement early-warning systems
- Streamline judicial proceedings
- Adopt co-ordinated second-chance strategies



- Develop a comprehensive strategic vision


Access to finance

Main achievements

- More robust legal framework, banking regulations aligned with Basel III requirements
- Credit guarantee funds established
- Encouraging initiatives on financial literacy

- Set up/reform credit guarantee schemes
- Support the development of leasing and factoring by completing and reviewing the ongoing reform of the legal framework
- Co-ordinate and formalize financial literacy efforts



Main achievements

- Regulatory environment improved
- E-procurement systems considerably developed
- Convergence of laws towards EU principles;
- Introduction of awareness-raising measures
- Export promotion agencies established
- Basic legal framework for e-payments and consumer protection in e-commerce

- Improve e-procurement
- Strengthen central regulatory and supervisory institutions
- Redefine institutional missions to focus on "industrial service provision" rather than "control"
- Strengthen the capacities of agencies and introduce trade finance tools.
- Continue reducing regulatory and administrative barriers to trade

Main achievements

- BDS provision included into relevant strategic frameworks
- Green policies developed
- Environmental legislation being updated
- Government support services expanding (techno-parks, innovation centres)
- Financial support instruments available (grants, fiscal incentives)


- Develop further tools (e.g. single information portals, co-ordination mechanisms)
- Link green policies to concrete action plans
- Develop green loan programs for SMEs
- Monitor the impact of financial and nonfinancial instruments
- Better design financial instruments to support innovation activities


Way forward

- 1. Ensure speedy vaccine roll-out and maintain targeted support introduced in response to Covid-19 for sectors hit hardest by the pandemic
- 2. Improve bankruptcy and debt restructuring procedures
- 3. Link SME support to structural reform priorities, such as green growth
- 4. Prioritise support for SME digitalisation to increase productivity and reduce digital divides
- 5. Continue to improve general framework conditions for entrepreneurship and investment to create a level-playing field
