Meeting Objectives

The third EU4Environment Regional Assembly will be held virtually on 21 September 2021. The meeting will:

- take stock of the Programme implementation, assess the progress and showcase key achievements;
- discuss the country specific and regional work plans for 2021-22;
- present and discuss the findings of the Result Oriented Monitoring (ROM) of EU4Environment carried out for the European Commission by independent evaluators; and
- update on governance arrangements and progress on communication.

The meeting will bring together the National Focal Points from the Ministries of Environment and of Economy of Eastern Partnership countries, the National Action Coordinators, representatives of the European Commission and the EU Delegations, EU Member States, civil society, and the EU4Environment Implementing Partners (OECD, UNECE, UNEP, UNIDO, and the World Bank).

The "European Union for Environment" (EU4Environment) Action aims to help six Eastern partner (EaP) countries (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Republic of Moldova, Ukraine) preserve their natural capital and increase people's environmental well-being. It is funded by the European Union and implemented jointly by five international organisations - OECD, UNECE, UNEP, UNIDO and the World Bank over 2019-22, with budget of about EUR 20 mln.
