




















Evidencing Process (greenlist)

- Company representatives invited to attend.
- 3 Bales Selected for breaking
- All material removed from container / trailer
- Contaminants removed and placed in quarantined area
- All evidence secured
- Offences put to governance panel for final decision regarding enforcement action.





CASTE STUDY 1 - Biffa

 Containers destined for Indonesia





 Numerous contaminants seized as evidence



- Material deemed as unfit for green list recovery, this was challenged by defendant
- Fine of £1.5 million plus costs



Case Study 2 – Op GARDEN



- Discharge data produced detailed movement of material when this should not have taken place.
- 6971 Illegal discharges across the 17 sites were the equivalent of one sewer pipe continuously pumping out minimally treated sewage for 7 years
- £90 Million fine plus costs
