Background

The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) is one of five partner agencies implementing an EU-funded EU4Environment Programme (2019 – 2022). This regional programme supports the Eastern Partnership (EaP) countries (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova, and Ukraine) in making policy planning and investment greener, stimulating the uptake of innovative products and technologies, and raising awareness about benefits of environmental action. The application of strategic approaches to waste management can assist in addressing countries' overarching waste management challenges. To this end, within EU4Environment's component 2.4 on "The use of strategic approaches on waste management" UNEP supports countries in promoting development of comprehensive sustainable waste management policies and policy instruments. More specifically, under *Activity 2.4.2 Initiating/assisting the establishment of Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) schemes*, UNEP provides technical assistance to partner countries in the establishment of EPR schemes for the packaging waste streams. This is achieved through the provision of advisory services and capacity development/trainings to policy makers, businesses and business associations, as well as Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and other stakeholders.

To this end, UNEP, in collaboration with the implementing partners, is organising the online Consultation Meeting on the Roadmap for Extended Producer Responsibility for Packaging Waste in Ukraine.

Meeting objectives, expected outputs and outcomes

- Present the findings and recommendations to establish an Extended Producer Responsibility system for the packaging waste in Ukraine,;
- Present the preliminary findings of the report and recommendation on engaging with the private sector in establishing the EPR systems for packaging in Ukraine,
- Discuss roadmap for seting-up of EPR for packaging in Ukraine; and
- Discuss future support that Ukraine may require in establishing the EPR principle.

Participants

The meeting will gather around 25 participants, including relevant governmental institutions, local authorities, UNEP, academia, private sector and CSOs in Ukraine.

The meeting will take place virtually via the Zoom platform. All registered participants will receive connection details to access the platform. English-Ukrainian simultaneous interpretation will be provided during the meeting.
