This event focuses on the following key objectives:

- Present the results of the industrial waste management activities to the representatives of the Economic Regions of Absheron-Khizi and Baku;
- Discuss the preliminary results of the waste mapping activities to refine findings and reach final results;
- Discuss the benefits and new opportunities related to waste mapping for the industrial enterprises in the selected focus sectors:
 - o Construction materials & components, including cement and clinker producers;
 - Metal smelting and processing;
 - Textile products components;
 - o Producers of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages;

Background

The technical event on waste mapping is held within the framework of the "Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities" activities led by UNIDO under the EU-funded "EU4Environment" Action. The objective here is to present the preliminary results of industrial waste management and waste mapping activities, to give the representatives of the enterprises from the Absheron-Khizi Economic Region and Baku Economic Region the opportunity to comment, provide inputs to develop further plans, and help finalise results.

Traditionally, waste management refers to the activities required to manage waste from its generation to its final disposal. This includes the collection, transport, treatment and disposal of waste, together with the monitoring and regulation of the waste management process and waste-related laws, technologies, and economic mechanisms. To this approach, the introduction of circular economy principles brings a new management model that emphasises prevention and responsible manufacture, reuse, repair, recycling of wastes to close resource loops in the value chain, opening more opportunities for new industries, jobs, reducing emissions and increasing efficient use of resources. An efficient and circular waste management system creates an increased business value, contributing to the sustainability of manufacturing industries and the promotion of economic opportunities.

The overall objective of waste mapping is then to identify, assess, and map waste streams in manufacturing enterprises in order to develop options for improving resource efficiency.

In Azerbaijan, UNIDO contracted a National Implementation Partner comprised of a consortium of companies led by ACE Group Consultants LLC to implement "Circular Economy and New Growth Opportunities" component within the EU4Environment Action. Overall, the work on Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production covers other activities such as:

- Supporting RECP Clubs
- Circular Economy: Industrial Waste Mapping
- Training of National Experts
- Additional RECP Assessments
- Raising awareness and sharing knowledge
