Highlights of the Achievements with EU4Environment support

- ✓ **Waste management strategy and action plan** development (adopted by the government)
- ✓ **Guidelines on SEA and EIA** for more effective environmental assessment
- ✓ **Introductory Green Economy e-course** hosted by the **Environmental Information and Education Center (EIEC)**, with 491 enrollments
- ✓ **Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP) legal provisions** developed (secondary legislation)
- ✓ **Sustainability criteria for prioritized products** developed (cleaning products and printing equipment), including manuals and guidelines for their use
- ✓ **8 SMEs supported in analysis and development of a roadmap for eco-innovation**
- ✓ An in-depth **training course on “Identification and assessment of remediation measures for significant environmental damage and preparation of a remediation plan”** (in person in Tbilisi)
- ✓ **Monitoring of RECP measures implementation** at 26 enterprises
- ✓ **16 member companies from 2 RECP clubs in 2 regions** (Kakheti and Mtskheta) implementing RECP Action plans after receiving certificates of attendance
