Highlights of the Achievements with EU4Environment support

- ✓ Waste management strategy and action plan development (adopted by the government)
- ✓ **Guidelines on SEA and EIA** for more effective environmental assessment
- ✓ Introductory Green Economy e-course hosted by the Environmental Information and Education Center (EIEC), with 491 enrollments
- ✓ Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP) legal provisions developed (secondary legislation)
- ✓ Sustainability criteria for prioritized products developed (cleaning products and printing equipment), including manuals and guidelines for their use
- ✓ 8 SMEs supported in analysis and development of a roadmap for eco-innovation.
- An in-depth training course on "Identification and assessment of remediation measures for significant environmental damage and preparation of a remediation plan" (in person in Tbilisi)
- ✓ Monitoring of RECP measures implementation at 26 enterprises
- ✓ 16 member companies from 2 RECP clubs in 2 regions (Kakheti and Mtskheta) implementing RECP Action plans after receiving certificates of attendance
