Highlights of the Achievements with EU4Environment support

- ✓ Introductory Green Economy online course in Ukrainian hosted on UN CC: e-Learning platform, with 235 enrolments
- ✓ Final draft Agreement on transboundary Environmental Impact Assessment (Ukraine-Romania)
- ✓ Draft Guidelines on Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) for Urban Planning Documents (2021-2022)
- ✓ 10 EaP GREEN demonstration SMEs monitored and 8 new RECP Business Cases published
- ✓ Industrial Waste Mapping assessment in 2 regions (Davydiv and Slavuta)
- Sustainability criteria and guidelines developed for government procurement of road construction materials and catering services
- E-procurement fields developed to insert voluntary/non-price sustainability criteria into government purchasing
- Eco-labelling standards developed for: I) furniture, flooring materials and other timber products and ii) polymer products
- ✓ Recommendations for elaboration of draft packaging waste law
- ✓ **Roadmap to establish an Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) system** for the packaging waste
