Result 1. Greener decision making (UNEP)

Progress from Sept 2021 to Sept 2022

- ✓ Regular support for organization/logistics of inter-ministerial dialogue on Green Economy (GE)
- ✓ In collaboration with the Academy of Public Administration (APA), GE topics were integrated into professional development courses on "Integrated strategic planning", "Development of public policies" and "Monitoring and evaluation of public policies"
- ✓ Catalogue of professional development courses for central and local public authorities was supplemented with an Environmental Management course

- ✓ Continued inter-ministerial dialogue on GE and overall oversight of EU4Environment progress
- ✓ Promotion (integration into APA programs) and delivery of the introductory GE course among civil servants
- ✓ Analysis of sectoral policies by trained civil servants, using skills obtained through the in-depth GE policy/analysis training course
- ✓ Elaboration of the Green Economy Program and Action Plan for 2023-2027
- ✓ Develop an **investment needs assessment** in alignment with review of national GE strategy
- ✓ Green Economy online course to be adapted and integrated on APA's "LearnIn Distance" training platform

Result 1. Greener decision making (UNECE: SEA/EIA)

Progress from Sept 2021 to Sept 2022

- ✓ Amended laws on EIA and on SEA: final drafts completed + the law on amendments adopted by Parliament of the Republic of Moldova in July 2022
- ✓ Two draft Guidelines on Quality Control of SEA Documentation
 and on Quality Control of Transboundary EIA Documentation
 prepared
- ✓ Needs assessment for SEA course for public servants, universitylevel course and awareness-raising materials

- ✓ Finalization of the two draft Guidelines in line with adopted amendments to the laws on SEA and EIA (Q4 2022):
 - Guidelines on Quality Control of SEA Documentation
 - Guidelines on QC of Transboundary EIA Documentation
- ✓ Preparatory phase and Scoping Report for a pilot SEA project (Q4 2022)
- ✓ SEA report of the pilot SEA (2023)
- Preparation of SEA course for public servants and university-level course on SEA and transboundary EIA (by Q1 2023)
- ✓ Preparation of the draft Order of the Minister (on assessment and certification of experts/legal persons for development of SEA and EIA documentation)
- Training Workshop on Quality Control of SEA and EIA Documentation -(late 2022)
- ✓ Development of awareness-raising materials (Q4 2022 Q1 2023)
- ✓ Other methodologies/guidelines on EIA and SEA (after finalizing the two Guidelines on Quality Control)

- ✓ Completing EIP prefeasibility assessments at IP Tracom and FEZ Valkanesz and preparing final report; UNIDO missions organized to validate the findings on 6-7 and 20-24 of June
- ✓ More than 60 companies were invited to RECP Clubs: the first meeting of RECP Club in Gagauzia on 21 of June, 8 companies as members; the first meeting of RECP Club in Cahul on 19 of July, 7 companies as members

Result 4. Ecosystem Services and Livelihoods (the World Bank)

Progress from Sept 2021 to Sept 2022

- Country work plan developed and agreed with the national counterparts
- ✓ Work launched on the following tasks:
 - ✓ Developing National Emerald Roadmap
 - ✓ Developing Emerald related legal framework for improved Emerald species and habitat conservation
 - ✓ Developing Guidelines for preparing Emerald management plans
 - ✓ Developing Emerald sites management plans for 3 selected sites
 - ✓ **Building human and informational capacity** to ensure sustainable management of the Emerald Network
 - ✓ Support to the development of the National Afforestation and Reforestation Program

- ✓ Develop draft Emerald Roadmap, Emerald related legislation and Guidelines for preparing Emerald site management plans, start work on developing Emerald sites management plans and conduct 4 capacity building events
- ✓ Conduct baseline mapping for community engagement in forests and NRM, support 8 communities to improve their practical knowledge on NRM
- ✓ Start work on identifying/mapping High Conservation Value Forests
- ✓ Start work on developing community-based participatory forest management model, and conducting forest management and silvopastoral planning for community-owned land
- ✓ Analytical work on domestic consumption of wood products to counteract illegal logging
- ✓ Web platform to promote marketing and sustainable trade of forest products
- ✓ **Diagnostic analysis** of national forest monitoring system and recommendations
- ✓ Pilot design and demonstration of a key-species traceability information system

- ✓ Promotion of EU4Environment on national web sites and in mass media




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
