Did you know that, in Moldova...

Road transport is responsible for **98%** of all greenhouse gas emissions from transport¹



Road transport is responsible for **96%** of ambient air pollution from transport²



- 66% increase of registered vehicles from 2007 to 2019 in Moldova³
- In 2017, about 40% of all vehicles failed to comply with any EU emission norm¹
- Cars use 10 times more public space than public transport and 140 times more public space than pedestrians⁴
