Training as part of EU4Environment

Key objectives:

- Aligning knowledge, decision-making, and stakeholder interaction mechanisms with environmental imperatives and making political leaders, civil servants and the general public aware and supportive of green growth
- Providing technical assistance and analytical support to assess existing/proposed policy documents as concerns their fitness in enabling a Green Economy









E-learning course "Green Transition in Eastern Partnership Countries"

- Moderated online course from February to April 2021
- Developed abilities of policy makers to analyze and implement green economy policies
- Interactive live webinars, forums, assessments, assignments and peer reviews
- Personal feedback and assistance provided to each participant
- 50 government-nominated civil servants (74% female; 26% male) from 6 EaP countries
- 97% agreed that they would likely use the knowledge acquired; 88% agreed that the content was relevant to their job
- Ministries of Environment, Economy, Territorial Development, Infrastructure, Energy, Agriculture, Transport, Finance, and Private Sector/SME development
