Country-specific:

- $\checkmark\,$ Complete work on advancing the Emerald Network in Moldova
- ✓ Continue work on community engagement in NRM:
- Conduct **baseline mapping** for community engagement in forests and NRM
- Develop **practical knowledge (e.g. tools, guidelines, training)** to improve communities' engagement in sustainable NRM. In Moldova the focus will be on participatory forest and pasture management planning
- ✓ Continue work on **promoting legal and deforestation-free trade in timber**
- ✓ Start work on enhancing strategic finance for the forest and NRM sectors

Regional:

- Organize regional workshops and study tours to exchange knowledge and experience on management of Natura 2000 sites in the EU countries
- ✓ Online training course on legal and deforestation-free timber trade
- ✓ Workshop on e-timber trade platforms and other innovative technologies
- Develop a regional document on the state of SFM and legal timber trade in EaP countries and recommendations for strengthening timber trade and export controls
