Georgia Context and Relevance EU4Environment Programme for the Country Needs

- National Forest Concept (2013) and Law of Georgia on the Forest Code of Georgia (2020)
- National Forest Inventory (2019-2023)
- NDC 2021: retention and increase of forests role in carbon sequestration; CAP 2024-2026
- 30x30 target under Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, CBD, COP15 (2022)
- Law on Biodiversity (submitted to Parliament in 2023)
- 66 approved Emerald Sites comprising over 1.3 million ha land = over 18% of Georgia territory
- National Forest Programme reviewed in 2023 national platform for stakeholder discussion on forest sector

- Identifying country investment and financing opportunities for forest and NRM: TOR agreed, awaiting contract award

- Learning from example of Natura 2000 institutional and legal frames, technical tools of management, engagement with communities, challenges encountered and overcome


