

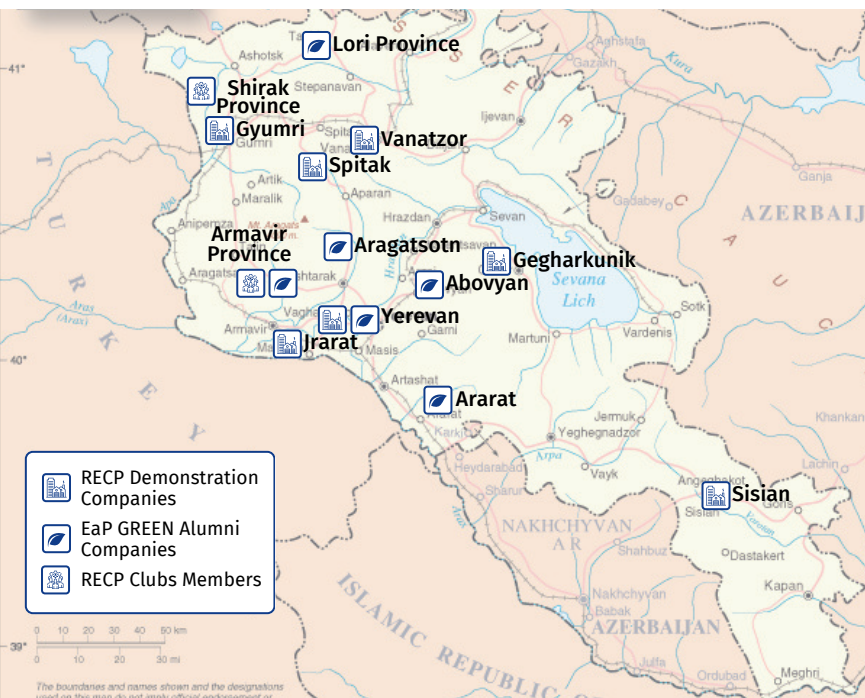

Recourse Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP)

RECP is the continuous application of preventive environmental strategies to processes, products, and services to increase efficiency and reduce risks to people and the environment.

In Armenia, the RECP Demonstration Project consisted of (1) training of RECP experts, (2) coaching of demonstration companies, and (3) facilitating RECP Clubs of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs) located in various regions. Selected companies received support in developing business plans to invest in selected RECP measures through own or borrowed financing.

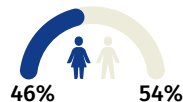

Industrial Waste Mapping (IWM) is a common method used to quantify and demonstrate the distribution and management of waste within a geographic area. The overall objective of IWM is to identify, assess, and map the waste streams of manufacturing enterprises to develop options for improved resource efficiency.

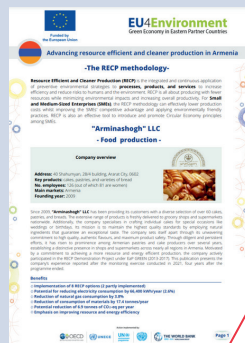
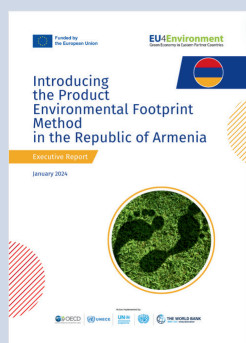

Product Environmental Footprint (PEF)

The Product Environmental Footprint (PEF) methodology is a multi-criteria measurement of the environmental performance of a good or service throughout its life cycle. It is promoted within the EU Single Market for Green Products initiative. The PEF information is produced to reduce and communicate the environmental impacts of goods or services, covering their entire life cycle (from the extraction of raw materials, through production and use, and the final management of waste).
