Key achievements through World Bank support

- **More than 2,100 hectares** of communal land are now managed as a model of long-term human–nature coexistence through the conservation and sustainable management of naturally regenerating forests
- **1,120 hectares of communal forests** are managed under Forest Management Plans enhanced to incorporate ecosystem services
- **More than 700 hectares** are covered by silvo-pastoral management plans integrating climate-resilient practices adapted from EU experience.

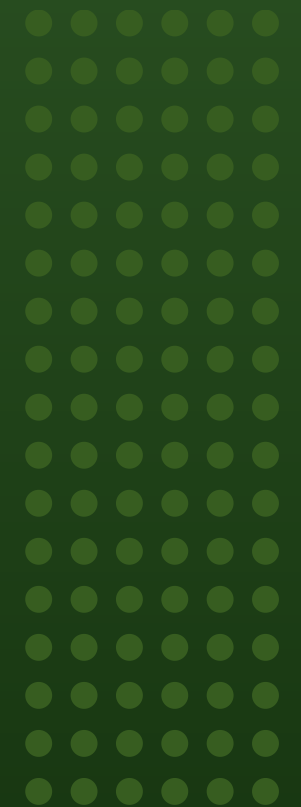


National Forest Extension and Rehabilitation Programme (2023–2032)



Targets:

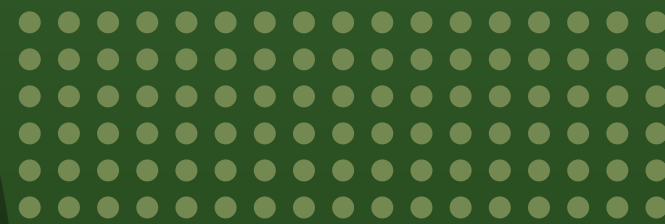
- Forest cover increase: from 13.8% to at least 17%
- 110,000 ha of new forests
- 35,000 ha of rehabilitated forests
- 14 000 jobs to rural communities.





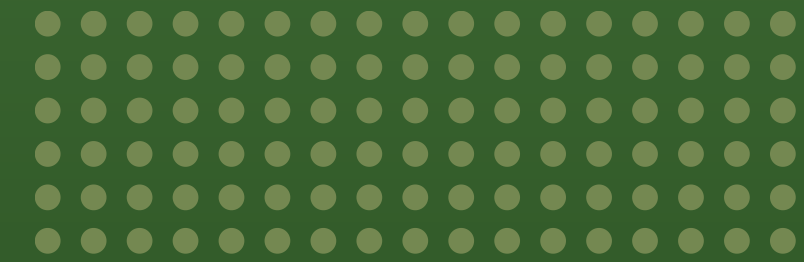

Identification of High Conservation Value Forests in the Republic of Moldova



About 175 500 hectares of forest land, representing 47.3% of the country's total forested area, are high conservation value forests (HCVFs).

This analysis shows that nearly half of the country's forest area (175,500 hectares) consists of High Conservation Value Forests (HCVFs), which are essential for protecting biodiversity and ensuring long-term environmental benefits.
